Glasgowlife Sport Coach and Officials Award

The Coach and Officials Award provides funding to support those volunteering in Glasgow to attend necessary qualifications building capacity within community sport.

Fund Facts

- 1. **Funding is retrospective upon course completion.** Applicants should submit confirmation of acceptance on the course with their application. A concession policy is in place for any volunteer requiring support in advance of the course.
- 2. Supports voluntary coaches in Glasgow attending a Level 1, Level 2 or equivalent qualification to a maximum of £250 in a 12-month period.
- 3. Supports voluntary officials in Glasgow attending an **introductory or full qualification for officials** to a maximum of **£250** in a 12-month period.
- 4. Glasgow Sport can provide support for up to **£500** total towards coaches and officials within any one club or sports organisation in a 12-month period. We would encourage you to speak to your club prior to applying.
- 5. Sportscotland offer a course subsidy for many level 1 and 2 qualifications here.
- 6. Applicants should check eligibility and apply at least **3 weeks** prior to the course.
- 7. Glasgow Life will advise the outcome within 6 weeks of receiving the application.
- 8. Fund recipients will submit a short impact report regarding the funding received.

Who is the award for?	 Volunteers within Glasgow based sport clubs and organisations or within Glasgow Sport programmes.
Who can't apply?	 Paid coaches who do not volunteer. Coaches from 'for profit' organisations. Coaches and Officials not volunteering within Glasgow.
What will we fund?	 NGB or sportscotland recognised Level 1, 2 or equivalent coaching courses. Approved NGB or sportscotland courses for officials.
What won't we be able to fund?	 Courses that have already taken place or have started. Level 3 or above and equivalent coaching qualifications. First Aid or Child Wellbeing qualifications
How much can I apply for?	• Applicants can apply for £250 of the remaining cost following any available subsidy. Glasgow Sport will determine the amount to be allocated to any successful application.
Key Information	 Funding is retrospective and made on receipt of paperwork. A concession policy is available for up-front payment <u>here.</u> All funding received towards the course should be noted in the application. Applicants are expected to cover the remaining balance of the course regardless of the funding panel decision.
